Kelly and her husband wanted to bring their daughters to America so they'd have enough to eat, a safe place to live, free from violence, and opportunities for a self-reliant future. "The situation was hard in Colombia. We knew it would be difficult to start from zero in America, but nothing is easy."

The day they arrived in Los Angeles, they were left on the streets of Skid Row in the rain, wondering where to turn. "We don't understand the language and we didn't know where to go or how to get out of Skid Row, so we walked deeper and deeper in," Kelly says. "We were scared for our girls."

Thankfully, kind strangers saw their need and reached out to help. "A man asked us what we were doing there and got us out. And a woman told us where to go for more help – that's how we found out about the Shepherd's House."

Kelly was overjoyed that her family now had a safe place to stay, while she and her husband looked for work and began building their new life. "You can feel the tranquility here," she says. Her husband has a job now and their 6-year-old daughter is going to school. "I was anguished because I'd never let her out of my sight before, but she likes it."

I thank God that we have somewhere to sleep and our daughters are OK.

Kelly continues looking for work, and her case manager is helping to find housing for Kelly and her family. Kelly dreams of having a place where her daughters can grow up in love and safety and have the opportunities their parents never had. "We want them to lack nothing," she says.

Her heart is overflowing with gratitude this Thanksgiving because YOUR loving support gave her family the confidence and support to rebuild their lives. "The Shepherd's House is helping us give our daughters stability and a good future."


