When Tania was 17, she fell in love with a man she thought was kind and loving. But, before long, he began abusing her and she was left with deep, emotional wounds. "I felt like I wasn't worth anything."

The abuse escalated with time, but **Tania was** afraid to leave because she had no way to provide for their two small children and no family to help her get on her feet. "I had no support whatsoever," she says.

Eventually, the domestic violence in their home led DCFS to take their older child. It was the catalyst Tania needed to overcome her fear. **She left the relationship, regained custody of her son and brought both of her children to our Casa de Vida Family Crisis Shelter,** where she found the time and encouragement she needed to change her family's future. "The staff understood what I was going through and made us feel safe and supported."

Knowing she and her children were safe allowed Tania to focus on healing from the trauma of her abuse, while taking steps that would lead to self-reliance. "The staff motivated me to find a therapist and go out to look for work," she says.

She now has a job and is saving money for a home where she can raise her children in safety and love. "Being here has made me a stronger mother and a stronger woman. Now I can provide for my kids and give them a better life."

Tania is excited to celebrate the restored hope her family has been given this Christmas – and wants YOU to know just how grateful she is. "I prayed for help and God brought us here, where they gave us strength and warmth and taught me to believe in myself again. I feel blessed to be the person I am today."
